



Dog Food Recall Updates: March – April 2007

A short note: Over the past few weeks I had been treating a number of dogs with what looked originally like food poisoning, liver cancers, etc. The remedy for the longest time had been Lycopodium. It was almost a specific for their condition. Almost always I suspected a liver involvement, had the liver enzymes tested and they were off the charts.

Well... as you have heard it was a problem with the food they were eating being contaminated. If you have one of these types of dogs, a proportion of which are dying, consider giving them Lycopodium. All that have taken it have recovered, quickly, thus far. Hope this helps.

I hope all is well with you and yours. I am sorry to be sending these notes in such a short manner but am pressed for time. I am making the assumptions that you have been following our discussions and techniques on provings, epidemics, homeopathic aids in epidemics, and the successes that we had during the Anthrax, SARS, and past Influenza epidemics.

I am also making the assumption that you received my previous note about using Lycopodium in the treatment of the dog/cat food epidemic. To recap, it seemed to me and then proved that Lycopodium will and has helped numerous animals that I had the opportunity to help in.

In reviewing the prior note, I mentioned that if you have an animal that is sick, to look at Lycopodium. Since then I again received numerous emails from other people telling me of their experiences since using the Lycopodium and the benefits that they saw in their animals, both in cats and dogs. Lycopodium is still the main remedy that is helping, though depending on the other symptoms attending, some may later need other remedies.

Also, I have found in the animals who primarily had renal destruction as well, that Lycopodium has been followed by Apocynum very well.

I left out a point though. And this follows from our discussions of the past most directly. If you know that your animals have been exposed to the food in question, i.e. has eaten this food, you may want to give them one dose of Lycopodium 30c.

From our discussions, Letters, and books of provings and epidemics, you already know why I am suggesting this protecting action.
